

Objectives of 4-H Camping

- o To have educational, recreational, and social experiences in outdoor living away from home.
- o To provide opportunities to meet and learn to get along with other people by living together and participating together in a camping experience.
- o To provide opportunities for youth to learn to take responsibility for their own decisions and actions.
- To provide new experiences for youth by exploring new interests or by exposing them to new approaches to old interests, such as nature, aquatics, music and other life skills that cannot be provided as effectively outside of camp.
- o To teach youth about citizenship and the importance of being a responsible citizen.

The total camp cost per child is \$250.00. This fee includes lodging, meals, class fees, camp T-shirt, insurance, counselor and adult supervision, program costs, and transportation. This Registration form and a \$50 non-refundable deposit will be required to secure your registration for camp. Refunds of remaining balance will be given only in the event of a serious accident/illness or family catastrophe. All refund requests must be submitted in writing to the Extension Office. Final payment is due on or before June 29th. Camp is limited. Registrations with a \$50.00 non-refundable will be accepted on a first-come basis beginning March 6 thru May 18 or until camp is full.

Early Bird Registration: Register before or on March 29th and you can save \$20.00. Not necessary to make full payment at time of registration to qualify for Early Bird Discount, but a \$50 non-refundable is required at time of registration to be eligible for the Early Bird. Campers who receive Early Bird Discount are still eligible for partial scholarships.

Partial Scholarship Applications are available on a limited basis.

To be considered for a partial scholarship, youth and their parent/guardian must complete a **Scholarship Application** form. Completed Scholarship Applications must be returned to the Alleghany Extension Office on or before May 18, 2017
